

EYFS Forest School Adventures – Autumn One 2022

Dear Parents / Carers,

We are delighted to say that **Squirrels Class will be going to Forest School this half term until the half term break starting this Wednesday 7th September in the morning** with Mrs Corps, Mrs Kirby and a team of long-term forest school community volunteers. Our Forest School takes place in a beautiful local private woodland, just a short walk away from school. They will get another half term of Forest School in Spring 2.

Forest School gives children the opportunity to explore their local woodland environment on a regular basis. Spending time outdoors children come closer to seasonal changes and begin to develop a meaningful connection and empathy with local plant and animal life. This term we will be making links to our Explore Curriculum; for example collecting data about the flora and fauna found on the site and investigating our impact (negative and positive) on the woodland. The children will direct their own play, choosing what to explore, either on their own or with peers and adults. The freedom to choose increases a child's determination to succeed, building personal resilience, encouraging natural fine and gross motor development, extending communication skills and affording a child a real sense of personal achievement. Children also enjoy the time and space to develop existing and new friendships. At our Forest School children begin to use basic bush craft techniques and tools, and experience fire craft. The children are encouraged to do some responsible risk-taking with adults on hand to play and for guidance. It is essential that the children wear sturdy shoes or wellington boots and a waterproof coat as well as layers to keep warm and that they can take off as the weather changes.
