A play is a performance of a story.



An actor is someone who performs in a play.



A play is usually performed on a stage.



The audience are the people watching the play.

There are many different ways to tell a story.

A nativity play is a play that tells the Christian story of how Jesus was born.

A musical is a play that has songs and actors talking.

The stage directions are the part of the script that tells the actors what to do or how to speak. You do not say the stage directions out loud.

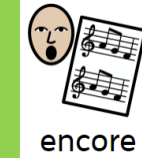
